Main Foyer

Access via the main foyer is from 9am until 30 minutes after the final performance of the day has finished. Access outside of those times is via Stage Door. Please make sure to always sign in at Stage Door prior to any session for emergency evacuation purposes.

The foyer's café is alongside the Sam Wanamaker Playhouse. Water can be found here or by the Information desk.

Globe Theatre and Sam Wanamaker Playhouse

Access via the main foyer is from 9am until 30 minutes after the final performance of the day has finished. Access outside of those times is via Stage Door.

Weston Foyer, Wolfson Lecture Theatre and Underglobe

These spaces are on the Lower Ground floor.

- The **Weston Foyer, Wolfson Lecture Theatre, Audre D. Carlin Reading Room and the John Wolfson Rare Book Room** are accessed via the stairs next to Box Office in the Main Foyer.
- The **Underglobe** is accessed via the West Block stairwell in the West Piazza.

The **Weston Foyer** is a throughway to the Wolfson Lecture Theatre and the Library and Archive. It also has loo facilities for the public during our opening hours.

The **Underglobe** is used as a function space by the Swan as well as for public Education events and occasionally Higher Education sessions. As with all our spaces, please do not enter the Underglobe unless it has been booked for you.

First Floor Office

The First Floor Office houses our Education and Theatre departments.

We operate an open-door policy and it's always nice to see our Faculty. We politely ask that you are mindful to the workloads of the Higher Education team.

The use of computers in the First Floor Office is limited to full-time or part-time permanent contract holders. Library and Archive

This space is directly opposite the Wolfson Lecture Theatre in the Weston Foyer.
